DAY 1 OF CLOSURE

ASYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

Complete provided learning or school activities at your own time & schedule.

• No assigned work **LEARNING**

GRADE K-6

- Paper work packets may be sent home in advance
- Online learning options available
- Focus on English Language Arts, Math, Social Studies, Science

7-12

- By 10am teachers will post work on Google Classroom or Hapara for all classes
- Students work independently

DAY 2 OF CLOSURE

SYNCHRONOUS LEARNING

Meet virtually together as a class at scheduled times. Attendance is required. If unable to attend, please email the teacher for excused absence.

EARLY • No assigned work **LEARNING**

GRADE K-6

- Scheduled virtual check-ins with teacher
- Activities and continued learning for enrichment and review
- May include offline work time

7-12

- Regular classes meet virtually using Google Meet or Zoom at the standard class time
- May include offline work time
- No class during flex time
