HEALTH AND LIFE SKILLS 7 COURSE OUTLINE MR. SHEEN

The aim of the Health and Life Skills program is to enable students to make well-informed healthy choices, and to develop behaviors that contribute to the well-being of self and others.

There are three areas of focus for Health and Life Skills 7.

1. WELLNESS CHOICES

Students will make responsible and informed choices to maintain health and to promote safety for self and others.

2. RELATIONSHIP CHOICES

Students will develop effective interpersonal skills that demonstrate responsibility, respect, and caring in order to establish and maintain healthy interactions.

3. LIFE LEARNING CHOICES

Students will use resources effectively to manage and explore life roles and career opportunities and challenges.

Students will have the opportunity to explore areas of gender and body images. How does the media play a major role in these issues?

Students will also be exposed to various career paths to help them identify areas of strengths and weaknesses, along with some direction as to future careers.

To help us meet curricular outcomes, we will be partnering up with a mature member of the community. We will make monthly visits with these people starting in January, and continuing to May. After visiting and gathering information, there will be a celebration evening where the students, seniors, family members, and community members will gather for an evening of sharing.
