- Value** One bursary throughout Livingstone Range School Division in the amount of \$2,000 will be given out yearly.
- Eligibility** Open to students registered in Grade 12 that are completing the requirements of a high school diploma and require assistance to advance to a **trade's post-secondary institution** (*specific to schools listed below*).
- Applicants must have demonstrated academic process and have shown the desire of advancing into their selected trade throughout Grades 10 to 12.
- Applicants are required to submit an original essay (350-500 words) telling of their background and what draws them to a career in trades. They will also highlight, with exemplars, what they have done during their high school years to prepare for this career choice.
- Two letters of recommendation are required. Letters may be provided by two school officials or a school official and an employer or a community leader representing a community based business or organization.
- Recipient must be registered in one of the following **post-secondary institutions**: Olds College, SAIT, NAIT (only if the course is not offered at SAIT), University of Lethbridge, Lethbridge College and the University of Alberta Agricultural Faculty.
- Apply** Applicants should consult with their Guidance Counsellor at their high school. Forms can be obtained from your school administrator(s) and/or Guidance Counsellor.
- Deadline &** All submissions are to be sent to LRSD Division Office in Fort Macleod attention: Nikki Lytwyn or email lytwynn@lrzd.ab.ca by **May 19, 2023**
- Process** An Awards Committee, consisting of 2 Board Trustees and the Superintendent of Schools review all applicants and determine the successful candidate(s).
