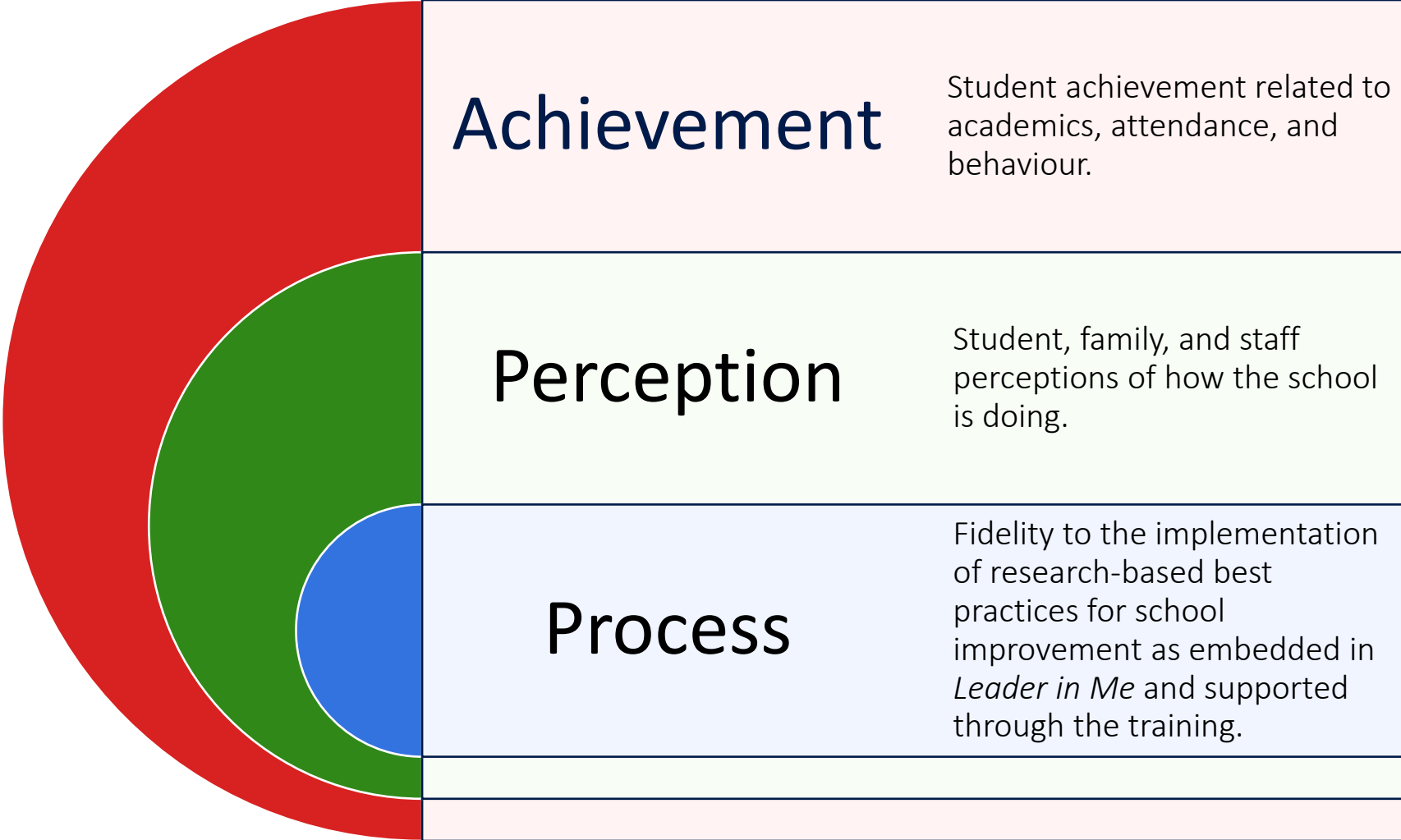

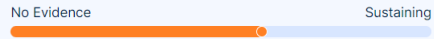

Leadership Results



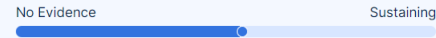
Fidelity to teaching leadership principles resulting in highly effective students and adults who are leaders in their school and community.
